Camp Director

Hired in January 2009, Emily Kiablick is in the midst of her third season at the helm of the Wheaton women's lacrosse program. Kiablick previously served as the head women's lacrosse and soccer coach at Roger Williams University from fall 2003 to fall 2008.

In soccer, Kiablick led the Hawks to their first NCAA Tournament appearance in 2008 and pushed the lacrosse team to an Eastern College Athletic Conference (ECAC) Tournament championship in just its third year after building the program from its inception in 2004. Her 2008 lacrosse team went 14-5 while advancing to The Commonwealth Coast Conference (TCCC) Tournament title game and an ECAC semifinal contest. Kiablick was twice named TCCC Coach of the Year. She also served as the athletic department's events coordinator.

Prior to being tabbed a head coach, Kiablick attended graduate school at her alma mater and fellow New England Women's and Men's Athletic Conference (NEWMAC) member Springfield College, earning a master's degree in physical education with a concentration in athletic administration in 2003. As a graduate associate, she assisted the lacrosse program for two seasons, helping lead the Pride to league regular season and tournament titles in 2002. Kiablick also served as an assistant women's soccer coach at Wesleyan University in 2001.

A 2001 Springfield graduate with a bachelor's degree in psychology, Kiablick was a four-year lacrosse and soccer player with the Pride. She was selected to the Intercollegiate Women's Lacrosse Coaches Association (IWLCA) All-New England second team as a junior. Twice named to a NEWMAC All-Conference lacrosse team, Kiablick was also tabbed an ECAC All-Star following her senior season. A two-time lacrosse captain, she was a soccer captain for one year while playing in the New England Women's Intercollegiate Soccer Association (NEWISA) Senior Bowl.
